2010 VACCINATION GUIDELINES

Often times many horse owners will adjust their vaccination schedule to fit individual needs and exposures. Below are the recommendations that Keystone Equine Vet makes to its clients.

Recommended

Rabies and Botulism - yearly Rhino/ Flu - twice a year

Tetanus - yearly West Nile - twice a year

East and West Encephalitis - growing number of cases is leading to more and more recommendations (EWE) for twice a year. (A fatal disease spread by biting insects)

Optional

Strangles

- \$35

Potomac Horse Fever - yearly in spring, again in late summer in high risk areas.

Strangles - yearly, intra-nasal
